This competition will be judged using the International Judging system.

COVID REQUIREMENTS

Please be mindful that Lee Valley London/Skate London must abide by guidelines set by the venue, BIS and the Government. Please do not attend if you are unwell or have tested positive for COVID or any other contagious disease.

Entries

Entries for individual events will be accepted in order of receipt of application forms and Entry Fee. Places may be limited due to available ice time. Lee Valley Ice Skating Club/Skate London, in consultation with the Competition Referee, reserves the right to limit the number of skaters in any over subscribed categories. If any of the categories are oversubscribed, they may be divided by age. For Beginners to Level 3, the age is calculated as at the closing date. For the ISU categories, age is calculated as at the previous 1st of July.

The Lee Valley London/Skate London Committee reserves the right to refuse entry without reason.

Withdrawals received after 5th April 2022 will not be refunded.

The organiser will provide and cover the expenses for travel, rooms and meals for participating accepted Judges and invited Officials. The organiser will not provide and cover the expenses for travel, rooms and meals for accepted competitors, or their coaches.

The Lee Valley London Skating/Skate London Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or add events to the final competition list subject to entries.

Lee Valley London Skating Club/Skate London cannot be held responsible for events outside of their control, e.g. ice or power failure, covid lockdown/restrictions, etc. We will not be held responsible for expenses incurred by competitors should any unplanned event occur.

LIABILITY - ALL

In accordance with ISU Rule 119 the organizer accepts no liability for injury or damages incurred by competitors or officials. The organizer will provide medical emergency aid during the competition. First Aid staff will be on duty in the first aid room adjacent to the ice pad for the duration of the competition.

Competitors/officials must report any injuries incurred to the registration desk staff.

LIABILITY International

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Lee Valley London Skating Club International Open Competitions, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.
